(1), Children Did Not Wash Their Hands Upon Arrival at the Center, After Each Visit to the Toilet, Before Eating, Before and After Water Activity Play, After... (1), and Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

There was one teacher with 7(seven) infants, one teacher with 9(nine) one year old children, one teacher with 14 (fourteen) two-year-old children and one teacher with 18 (eighteen) chi
