On May 11, 2026 and May 12, 2026, five children ages three to five years of age were left unsupervised. The amount of time the children were left alone is unknown. Violation pending provider response

A preschool teacher was observed by staff members and parents on several occasions yelling at a group of preschool age children. Violation pending provider response

In child care centers, toilet tissue paper shall be provided in each toilet room and stored in a clean, dry place. The toilet room shall include or be adjacent to a handwash lavatory. Storage in toilet rooms shall be limited to

● **Monthly Playground Inspections Were Not Completed And/or They Were Not Completed by an Individual Trained in Playground Safety Requirements.**
