Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Crib Sheets Were Not Changed as Needed or at Least Daily. (1), Outdoor Play Area Was Not Enclosed by Fence with a Minimum Height of 4 Feet. (1), and Children Under One Year of Age Were Not Kept Separate From Children Two Years and Older. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Crib Sheets Were Not Changed as Needed or at Least Daily.**

One crib sheet was found to be soiled. The provider addressed this during the visit by replacing it with a clean crib sheet. Violation corrected during visit

● **Outdoor Play Area Was Not Enclosed by Fence with a Minimum Height of 4 Feet.**

The top of the fence, less than six feet, was not free from protrusions. Portions of the chain link fencing was less than 4 feet high. There is also a portion of the fence near the climbing structure that is

● **Children Under One Year of Age Were Not Kept Separate From Children Two Years and Older.**

There were two 6 month old children in space #2 with children two years old and older. There was also a 2 year old child in Space 3 with the 6 month old children. Violation corrected during visit

● **Cribs and Playpens Were Placed So That Children Occupying Them Had Access to Cords or Ropes.**

In the space for infant children a crib was placed next to a window where the cord from the blinds were observed hanging next to the crib. Violation corrected during visit

● **Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age.**

Plastic bags stored in the children's cubbies were accessible to the children in the space for infants. Violation corrected during visit
