(1), and All Staff Did Not Review the Center's EPR Plan During Orientation And/or on an Annual Basis with the Trained Staff. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Child Was Handled in a Rough Way, Including Shaking, Pushing, Shoving, Pinching, Slapping, Biting, Kicking, or Spanking.**

On 3/4/26 a teacher was observed on the center's camera pulling several children by their arm and abruptly pulling toys out of the children's hands. Violation con
