Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Electrical Cords Were Accessible to Infants and Toddlers. (1), When Three Year Old Children and Older Were in Care, the Materials and Equipment in the Activity Area Was Not in Sufficient Quantity to Allow at Least Three... (1), and The Indoor And/or Outdoor Premises Was Not Checked Once a Day, Prior to Initial Use, Ensuring Debris, and Broken Equipment Was Removed and Disposed Of. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.

An electrical cord to a dehumidifier in space 6 was accessible to infants. The dehumidifier was removed during the visit. Violation corrected during visit
