Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Appliances with Heating Elements, Such as Bottle Warmers, Crock Pots, Curling Irons, and Electrical Cords Were Accessible to Children. (1), When Medication Is Administered, Authorization for the Operator to Administer the Specific Medication According to the Parent's or Health Care Professional's... (1), and Breast Milk, Formula, and Other Bottled Beverages Sent From Home Were Not Fully Prepared, Dated, and Labeled with Individual Child's Names. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Appliances with Heating Elements, Such as Bottle Warmers, Crock Pots, Curling Irons, and Electrical Cords Were Accessible to Children.**

On the day of the visit, a space heater was in operation and in the play area accessible to children. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received

● **When Medication Is Administered, Authorization for the Operator to Administer the Specific Medication According to the Parent's or Health Care Professional's...**

instructions was not on file and available. I observed an Aquaphor ointment for a toddler with no permission to administer form

● **Breast Milk, Formula, and Other Bottled Beverages Sent From Home Were Not Fully Prepared, Dated, and Labeled with Individual Child's Names.**

I observed breast milk in the refrigerator for the toddler with no name or date labeled on the bottles. Violation confirmed corrected by letter r

Oct 27, 2023 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **Number of Children Exceeded Number Allowed.**

I observed eleven (11) children at the family child care home upon arrival today. Per the permit, Ms. Evans cannot exceed eight (8) children. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 11/6/2023
