(1), and A Drug or Medication Was Administered Without Written Authorization And/or Instructions From a Child's Parent or Authorized Health Professional. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs.**

A staff member was observed using profanity in front of children under 1 year of age. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/10/2026

● **Menus for All Meals and Snacks Were Not Current or Posted Where Easily Seen by Parents and Cook.**

Snack menus were not posted. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/10/2026

Nov 10, 2025 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **A Drug or Medication Was Administered Without Written Authorization And/or Instructions From a Child's Parent or Authorized Health Professional.**

An epi-pen in space 11 had an emergency action plan but not a medication permission form. Diaper cream in space 7 did not have a permission

● **The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment.**

Mulch under and around all stationary gross motor equipment was not 6 inches in depth. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 11/21/2025
