(1), Air Conditioning Units Were Accessible or Did Not Have a Guard to Keep Objects From Being Thrown Into the Unit. (1), and Staff Did Not Complete the Health and Safety Training Within One Year of Employment. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A staff member who was employed on 3/10/25 did not complete Health and Safety Training within one (1) year of employment. This staff member did not complete "Medication in Child Care" training. Violat

Table was not cleaned and sanitized appropriately before meals. A staff member sprayed a solution on the table and immediately wiped out before seating children in space #5. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from
