(1), and Each Staff Member Did Not Have the Required Medical Report, Proof of Tuberculosis Test or Screening And/or Completed Health Questionnaire in a Medical File,... (1). During the visit, I observed one (1) employee file that had six (6) on-going training hours documented rather than the required eight (8) hours. Viol
