Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1), A Child Care Operator Did Not Notify the Division of Any New Child Care Providers Who Were Hired or Moved Into the Home Within Five Business Days by Submitting... (1), and Operator Has Not Scheduled and Obtained a Fire Inspection Within 12 Months of the Previous Inspection. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
