● **An Individual Written Feeding Plan Was Not Provided by Child's Parent or Health Care Provider or Was Not Followed and Posted.**

One infant in Space 1 did not have an infant feeding plan on file or in the classroom. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 9/22/2

● **Staff Required to Receive On-going Training Had Not Completed the Required Number of Hours According to Their Education and Experience.**

Staff person J.A. did not complete the required number of on-going training hours. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on

● **The Trained Staff Did Not Review the EPR Plan Annually or When Information in the Plan Changed to Ensure All Information Was Current.**

The EPR plan had not been reviewed since 2017 according to the plan cover page. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 9/22/
