Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1), Monthly Playground Inspections Were Not Completed And/or They Were Not Completed by an Individual Trained in Playground Safety Requirements. (1), and Center Staff Did Not Follow the EMC Plan. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

Based on the three (3) staff interviews conducted and a review of the outdoor learning environment it was observed that two active anthills had been present on the playground while children were in care. Violatio

● **Monthly Playground Inspections Were Not Completed And/or They Were Not Completed by an Individual Trained in Playground Safety Requirements.**

It was observed that a monthly outdoor inspection completed on October 1, 2025 did not have documentation reflecting the two (2) active anthills

● **Center Staff Did Not Follow the EMC Plan.**

Based on the three (3) staff interviews conducted, a review of the facility's operational policies and a review of the facility's Emergency Medical Care Plan it was observed that center staff did not follow the EMC Plan. Violation confirmed co

● **Application for Enrollment Did Not Include All Required Information.**

It was observed that a child had an application on file that did not include all required information. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/8/2025
