A child was given yogurt during breakfast on March 30, 2026, which contradicts the documentation from the physician. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/16/2026

● **Operator Has Not Scheduled and Obtained a Fire Inspection Within 12 Months of the Previous Inspection.**

Operator did not submit the original approved report to DCDEE within one week of the inspection visit on a form provided by the Division. A fire inspection report was completed on 2/

● **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**
