● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

A metal bus and climber showed signs of rust on the playground for three and four year old's. Walls, sinks, trashcans, toys showed signs of dust and buildup throughout the facility. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received

● **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**
