- **Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information.**

In Space 4, the Permission to Administer form for Hydrocortisone cream did not include the length of time the authorization is valid. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 6/24/2025

- **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of First Aid training from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. A staff member hired 2/13/2023 did not have certifica
