In indoor space #5, the walls have chipped paint that is accessible to the children. Also, in space #5, one (1) outlet plug is too loose to hold the safety outlet cover. Violation confirmed corrected by letter rec

- **Equipment and Furnishings Were Not Sturdy, Stable and Free of Hazards.**
In space four (4), the wooden cabinet door under the handwashing has chipped wood around the bottom of the door. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/20/2025
