Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing. (1), Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1), and Prescribed Medicine Was Not in Original Labeled Container or Accompanied by Signed and Dated Written Instructions From Prescribing Physician or Health Care... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**
Mulch surfacing on the lower side of each of the spring rockers measured 4 inches instead of 6 inches. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 11/6/2025
- **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**
unless located behind furniture or equipment that cannot be moved by a child. In space #3, an outlet was uncovered. Violation
- **Prescribed Medicine Was Not in Original Labeled Container or Accompanied by Signed and Dated Written Instructions From Prescribing Physician or Health Care...**
professional. An epi pen was not in in an original container with the pharmacy label. Violation confirmed corrected by letter rec
- **All Staff, Including the Director, Did Not Have an Annual Health Questionnaire on File Following the Initial Medical Statement.**
New staff FR did not have a copy of this in her file. Violation corrected during visit
