(1), and Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

The large bolts were sticking out of some of the black borders. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/30/2025

● **Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container.**

There was Benadryl medication that was not in locked storage in the classroom for infants. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/

● **Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information.**

One child with asthma medication did not have a medication administration authorization form on file. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 10/30/2025

● **Application Did Not Have a Medical Action Plan Attached for Any Child with Health Care Needs Such as Allergies, Asthma, or Other Chronic Conditions That...**

require specialized health services. One child with seizure medication did not have a medical action plan on file. Violation confirm

A staff member in the classroom for two-year old children was observed changing diapers. She wore the same pair of gloves as she diapered two children. She did not change gloves or wash hands in between diaper

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
