On the playground used by preschool children, two (2) fence posts along the front, street side had holes that were rusted and created sharp edges. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3

● **Caregivers Did Not Document Compliance with Visually Checking on Sleeping Infants Aged 12 Months or Younger And/or the Documents Were Not Maintained for A...**

minimum of one month. Sleep checks were not recorded for an infant who was present from 8am to 5:30pm on March 2, 2026. Violation

● **Operational Policies Were Not Discussed with Parents on or Before the Child's First Day And/or They Were Not Notified in Writing of All Changes.**

Three (3) of four (4) child files reviewed did not include documentation of a review of operational policies. Violation confirmed corrected
