Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Emergency Medical Care Information Was Not on File in the Center on the Child's First Day of Attendance And/or Was Not Updated as Changes Occurred or at Least... (1), Bed, Cribs, Playpens, Cots or Mats Were Not Placed at Least 18" Apart or Separated by Partitions When in Use. (1), and Electrical Cords Were Accessible to Infants and Toddlers. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Emergency Medical Care Information Was Not on File in the Center on the Child's First Day of Attendance And/or Was Not Updated as Changes Occurred or at Least...**
annually for each child. Two children's files contained the forms but were not completed. Six children's forms had not been up to date.

Mar 26, 2025 3 Findings ● 3 Important

- **Bed, Cribs, Playpens, Cots or Mats Were Not Placed at Least 18" Apart or Separated by Partitions When in Use.**
Three cots sitting on the group area rug were closer than 18 inches apart in classroom # 8. The cots were moved during the visit. Violation corrected during visit

- **Electrical Cords Were Accessible to Infants and Toddlers.**
A radio cord sitting on a cubby was hanging down while plugged in accessible to the children in classroom #9-which has one year old children present. The cord was made inaccessible during the visit. Violation corrected during visit.
- **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**
which may be hazardous to a child if ingested, inhaled, or handled were not stored in a locked room or cabinet. A used bowl brush was found in the room.
