Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1), Children Between 12 and 24 Months of Age Were Grouped with Children 3 Years of Age or Older. (1), and Special Diet or Food Allergy Information Was Not Posted Where They Can Be Seen in Food Preparation and Eating Areas. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

A child went indoors to use the restroom without any adult being aware he was gone until he returned to the outdoor play area. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 5/4/2026

● **Children Between 12 and 24 Months of Age Were Grouped with Children 3 Years of Age or Older.**

There were two (2) groups of children, ages one to three years, outside on the same outdoor area. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 5/4/2026

● **Special Diet or Food Allergy Information Was Not Posted Where They Can Be Seen in Food Preparation and Eating Areas.**

Special diet for children were not posted in the eating areas. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/5/2026

● **The Written Feeding Plan Did Not Include the Child's Name, Parent Signature, And/or Was Not Dated When Received by the Center.**

Two (2) children's feeding plan did not have the parent signature. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/5/2026

● **The Written Feeding Plan Was Not Modified as the Child's Needs Changed.**

One (1) child's feeding plan did not include baby food modification. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/5/2026
