Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Diapers Were Not Changed Whenever They Were Soiled or Wet And/or Were Changed on a Shift Basis. (2), Operator Has Not Scheduled and Obtained a Fire Inspection Within 12 Months of the Previous Inspection. (1), and Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Aug 21, 2025 1 Finding ● 1 Important

- **Diapers Were Not Changed Whenever They Were Soiled or Wet And/or Were Changed on a Shift Basis.**
In space #2 where infants are cared for each child was not changed whenever they were wet/soiled. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/27/2025

Dec 5, 2024 1 Finding ● 1 Important

- **Operator Has Not Scheduled and Obtained a Fire Inspection Within 12 Months of the Previous Inspection.**
Operator did not submit the original approved report to DCDEE within one week of the inspection visit on a form provided by the Division. Fire inspection was not completed annually.

Aug 22, 2024 1 Finding ● 1 Important

- **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**
On August 15, 2024 a two year old child was left on the playground alone for three minutes. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/26/2024
