On March 5, 2026, a staff member failed to provide adequate supervision when the staff member stood in the doorway of the classroom while speaking to a pers

A current schedule was not posted in one of the Toddler rooms, it was dated July 15th-`19th. This was corrected during today's visit. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/6/2024
