Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were New Staff, Who Had Contact with Children, Did Not Receive at Least 16 Hrs. Orientation Within First 6 Weeks. (1), Incident Reports Were Not Completed Each Time a Child Was Injured, It Did Not Include All the Information Required in Rule, It Was Not Signed by the Parent... (1), and Incident Logs Were Not Completed and Maintained as Required. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

T. Thompson had not received 16 hours of orientation. Her hire date was 8/2025. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/2/2025

● **Incident Reports Were Not Completed Each Time a Child Was Injured, It Did Not Include All the Information Required in Rule, It Was Not Signed by the Parent...**

● **Incident Logs Were Not Completed and Maintained as Required.**

A staff member failed to utilize an incident log with all information required within the child care rule for an incident that occurred on 7/25/24. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/9/2024
