● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

On the playground, the orange climbing structure had missing or broken parts. The house structure had several rusting areas. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/1/2025

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of First Aid training from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. Documentation was not on file for one staff member. V

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in CPR Training Appropriate to the Age of the Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of the CPR course from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. Documentation was not on file for one staff member

● **Each New Employee Did Not Complete, Within the First Two Weeks of Employment, Six Clock Hours of Training in Required Topic Areas.**

One staff member received 3 hours and 40 minutes of training within the first two weeks of hire in 4 out of the 5 required topic areas. Violation confirme

● **The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment.**

On the playground, the surfacing under the orange climbing structure measured less than 6 inches in several areas. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/1/2025

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
