(1), Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1), and Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

In the three- year- old classroom the current lesson plan was not posted. This violation was corrected during the visit.

In the two year old classroom there were zip lock bags in the activity center within reach in of the children. This violation was corrected

Dec 2, 2024 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **Outdoor Play Area Was Not Enclosed by Fence with a Minimum Height of 4 Feet.**

The top of the fence, less than six feet, was not free from protrusions. A portion of the fence facing the street below 4 feet measuring 3 feet 6 inches and 3 feet 7 inches in multiple places along the fence.
