Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Electric Fans Were Not Mounted Out of Reach or Did Not Have a Mesh Guard to Prevent Access. (1), When Children 3 Years and Older Were in Care, Screen Time Was Not Used to Stimulate a Developmental Domain; Was Not Limited to 30 Minutes a Day and No More... (1), and All Electrical Appliances Were Not Used in Accordance with the Manufacturers Instruction. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
