(2), Operator Has Not Scheduled and Obtained a Fire Inspection Within 12 Months of the Previous Inspection. (1), and Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Operator did not submit the original approved report to DCDEE within one week of the inspection visit on a form provided by the Division. The most recent fire inspection was dated Oc

- **Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container.**

One emergency medication was stored in the ready to go bag hanging on a hook on the side of a shelf below five feet. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up

- **Outdoor Play Area Was Not Enclosed by Fence with a Minimum Height of 4 Feet.**

The top of the fence, less than six feet, was not free from protrusions. The fence surrounding the outdoor play area measured four feet on the front and right fence lines, three feet and ten inches on the bac

Feb 25, 2025 1 Finding ● 1 Important

- **Outdoor Play Area Was Not Enclosed by Fence with a Minimum Height of 4 Feet.**

The top of the fence, less than six feet, was not free from protrusions. The fence around the outdoor play area measured three feet and ten inches from the top the mulch to the top of the fence. Violation con
