Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Medication Authorization, Giving the Caregiver Standing Authorization Did Not Meet the Specifications in Rule. (1), A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1), and Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

One child in Space 2A had an Epi-Pen that did not have the accompanying permission to administer authorization. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

A bolt was missing in the upper inside corner of the the yellow playhouse outside on the large preschool playground. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/23/2025

Jul 17, 2024 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**
