(1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

On September 30, 2025, in response to a three-year-old child not sitting in their chair, a staff member created an unsafe environment by utilizing a hot glue gun to put hot glue onto the seat of the chair and the

● **A First Aid Information Sheet Was Not Posted in a Place for Referral And/or the Information Sheet Did Not Include All the Required Information.**

Although the poster was available in the classroom, on September 30, 2025, a staff member did not utilize the first aid poster to treat a chi

● **Center Staff Did Not Follow the EMC Plan.**

On September 30, 2025, a staff member did not follow the center's emergency medical care (EMC) plan by not contacting an administrator after a three-year-old child was burned on the back of their thighs. Violation confirmed corrected by letter

● **Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs.**

On September 30, 2025, a staff member did not inform anyone of a burn injury to a three-year-old child's thighs. As a result, the injury went untreated at the cent

● **A Child Was Handled in a Rough Way, Including Shaking, Pushing, Shoving, Pinching, Slapping, Biting, Kicking, or Spanking.**

On September 30, 2025, a staff member put hot glue on a chair and intentionally placed a three-year-old child on the chair in effort to redirect a child's behavior
