(2), All Staff, Including the Director, Did Not Have an Annual Health Questionnaire on File Following the Initial Medical Statement. (1), and All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **All Staff, Including the Director, Did Not Have an Annual Health Questionnaire on File Following the Initial Medical Statement.**

All staff had not completed the health questionnaire since March 20, 2025. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 3/30/2026

Apr 3, 2025 3 Findings ● 3 Important

- **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

The fence of the large outdoor play area has openings between the bottom of the fence and the ground in several places. This could allow for vermin to enter the playground. Violation confirmed corrected by letter

- **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of First Aid training from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. First Aid certification for three staff had expired

- **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in CPR Training Appropriate to the Age of the Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of the CPR course from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. CPR certification had expired for three staff. Vio
