● 5 Important

Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1), A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1), and Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

**Feb 4, 2026** 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

Based on the information obtained there is an ongoing issues where a caregiver frequently falls asleep while in charge of a group of children during naptime. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 2/

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

Based on the information obtained a caregiver is known to frequently carry hot coffee around children in the room and outside despite the operation having rules that this is not allowed. Violation confirmed corre

**Oct 14, 2025** 1 Finding ● 1 Important

● **Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs.**

It was determined that on 10/1/25 a child was not cared for in a nurturing manner when a caregiver grabbed the child's hair to redirect them. Violation confirmed c

**Sep 12, 2024** 1 Finding ● 1 Important

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in CPR Training Appropriate to the Age of the Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of the CPR course from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. One staff was observed to not have completed CPR
