Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Daily Records of Arrival and Departure Times for Children at the Center Were Not Maintained as Children Arrive and Depart And/or Were Not Made Available For... (1), A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1), and Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

In space 122A, disinfectant and hand sanitizer was not maintained at five feet off the floor. A staff member's purse was stored in an unlocked filing cabinet, not five feet from the floor. Violation corrected dur

● **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**

unless located behind furniture or equipment that cannot be moved by a child. In space 122A, an electrical power strip did no

● **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**
