Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Medication Authorization, Giving the Caregiver Standing Authorization Did Not Meet the Specifications in Rule. (2), New Staff, Who Had Contact with Children, Did Not Receive at Least 16 Hrs. Orientation Within First 6 Weeks. (1), and Staff Did Not Complete the Health and Safety Training Within One Year of Employment. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **New Staff, Who Had Contact with Children, Did Not Receive at Least 16 Hrs. Orientation Within First 6 Weeks.**

New staff orientation was not documented adequately to show that the staff person, who began employment in August 2025, had received the required orientation. Violation correct

● **Medication Authorization, Giving the Caregiver Standing Authorization Did Not Meet the Specifications in Rule.**

Parental permission to administer asthma medication to a child expired in March 2026. Violation corrected during visit

● **Staff Did Not Complete the Health and Safety Training Within One Year of Employment.**

Information could not be located in one group leader's file, regarding when she completed health and safety training or to determine when the group leader needed to complete the trainings again. Viol
