Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Incident Reports Were Not Completed Each Time a Child Was Injured, It Did Not Include All the Information Required in Rule, It Was Not Signed by the Parent... (1), Emergency Information Did Not Name Childs Health Care Professional. (1), and Child Care Providers Scheduled to Work in the Infant Room, Did Not Complete ITS-SIDS Training Within Two Months of Employment or Did Not Complete the Training... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information.**

In Spaces 1b and 2b, four permission forms for sunscreens did not include the brand name of the sunscreen. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 8/11/2024

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
