(2), Staff Required to Receive On-going Training Had Not Completed the Required Number of Hours According to Their Education and Experience. (1), and Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
