Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information. (1), Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs. (1), and Each Staff Member Did Not Have the Required Medical Report, Proof of Tuberculosis Test or Screening And/or Completed Health Questionnaire in a Medical File,... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information.**

A child in classroom space #7 had an Epi-Pen for a food allergy. There was no medication authorization form from a parent to administer the Epi-Pen. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider

● **Each Child Was Not Attended to in a Nurturing and Appropriate Manner, or in Keeping with the Child's Developmental Needs.**

The director observed on the video that a caregiver lifted an infant by the infant's arm. The staff person is no longer employed at the center. Violation correct

● **Each Staff Member Did Not Have the Required Medical Report, Proof of Tuberculosis Test or Screening And/or Completed Health Questionnaire in a Medical File,...**

maintained separately from the staff member's individual personnel file. The negative TB test for a staff person, who began empl

Nov 4, 2025 2 Findings ● 2 Important

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

A staff member did not ensure a one-year-old child was securely placed on a diaper changing table resulting in the child rolling off the table onto the floor. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made
