(2), The Child Care Administrator and All Staff Did Not Complete the Recognizing and Responding to Suspicions of Child Maltreatment Training Within 90 Days Of... (1), and A Child Was Restrained as a Form of Discipline and the Child's Safety or the Safety of Others Was Not at Risk. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

employment. One staff member did not have the Child Maltreatment training completed after 5 years of last training date. Violation

unless located behind furniture or equipment that cannot be moved by a child. In one classroom a plug outlet was not covered.

The Director, Patti Triplett used her body weight to restrain a child on the floor. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 7/22/2024

● **An Incident Report Was Not Completed and Mailed to a Division Representative Within Seven Days After the Incident When Medical Treatment Was Required.**

On 6/5/24 A child had a seizure, due to a fever, and was taken to the hospital by the ambulance, and no incident report was submitted

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
