Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Accurate Records Were Not Maintained for All Children. (1), Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1), and The Center Did Not Comply with the Permit Restrictions. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Accurate Records Were Not Maintained for All Children.**

One child's record was missing a medical form, a discipline policy, a shaken baby policy and the summary of the law. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/9/2025

Jan 14, 2025 1 Finding ● 1 Important

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

I observed one classroom of children using the two bathrooms in the hallway. Children were in both bathrooms and some children were in the hallway against the wall. The teacher was sitting on a bench in the hallway and could not

Jul 8, 2024 1 Finding ● 1 Important

● **The Center Did Not Comply with the Permit Restrictions.**

During the visit, there were four children ages 6 and 7 being cared for in space 1125 and the Notice of Compliance restricts age range to 3 -5 year olds. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/12/2024
