Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Screen Time Was Not Prohibited for Children Under the Age of Three. (1), Monthly Check for Hazards on the Outdoor Play Area Was Not Completed Using a Form Supplied by the Division. (1), and Electrical Outlets Not in Use Were Not Covered. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

### ● Screen Time Was Not Prohibited for Children Under the Age of Three.

The operator did not offer alternative activities for children under the age of three years. Upon arrival to the facility, children two and three years of age were observed watching a cartoon with Donald Duck and Goo

### ● Monthly Check for Hazards on the Outdoor Play Area Was Not Completed Using a Form Supplied by the Division.

A playground inspection was not observed on file for the month of September, 2025. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/3/2025

### ● Electrical Outlets Not in Use Were Not Covered.

One electrical outlet near the refrigerator was observed to not have a safety cover. Violation corrected during visit

### ● Record of Monthly Fire Drills, Giving the Date, Time of Day and Length of Time to Evacuate, and Operator's Signature, Were Not Available.

A fire drill had not been recorded since 6/16/2025. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/3/2025

### ● Copy of Each Child's Health Assessment, Including the Operator's Own Preschool Child(ren), Was Not on File Within 30 Days of Enrollment.

Health assessments for two children enrolled were not observed to be on file for review. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from prov
