In space #4 and #10, there were no developmentally appropriate books accessible to the children. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provide

● **Each Child's Bed, Cot, or 2" Mat Was Not Individually Assigned and Identified.**

In space #1, three infants were placed in a crib labeled with other children's names. In space #4 and space #6, the cot charts did not match the cots. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from

● **Toys and Other Mouth-contact Surfaces Were Not Cleaned and Sanitized Daily When Used or Cleaned More Frequently if Visibly Dirty.**

In spaces #4, #5, #7, the shelving and storage containers used to store toys visibly dirty with debris and dust. Violation confirmed corrected by letter r
