Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Minimum Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes for the Number and Ages of Children in Care Were Not Met. (1), Diapers Were Not Changed Whenever They Were Soiled or Wet And/or Were Changed on a Shift Basis. (1), and Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
