Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment. (2), All Staff Records, Except Financial Records, Were Not Made Available for Review. (1), and Each New Employee Did Not Complete, Within the First Two Weeks of Employment, Six Clock Hours of Training in Required Topic Areas. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment.**

The depth of the soft surface under a critical height climber on the larger playground did not meet requirements. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/17/2024

Dec 5, 2023 4 Findings ● 4 Important

● **All Staff Records, Except Financial Records, Were Not Made Available for Review.**

One new staff person, EC, did not have her staff file on site or available for review. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 12/13/2023

● **Each New Employee Did Not Complete, Within the First Two Weeks of Employment, Six Clock Hours of Training in Required Topic Areas.**

One new staff, SB, did not have the required orientation within the first two weeks of employment. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from p

● **Substitutes and Volunteers Counted in Ratio Were Not Informed of the Center's EPR Plan and Its Location.**

Documentation of this notice was not maintained on file or in a file designated for emergency preparedness and response plan documents. One staff person, SB, was not informed of wh

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● **The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment.**

On the playground area under the swings and equipment there was not the correct depth of loose surfacing. There needed to be a least 6 inches of surfacing and there was less than one inch under the sw

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
