(1), and Medical Exam or Health Assessment Record Was Not on File Before or Within 30 Days After Admission. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

A three-year old child ran out of the center after his/her mother and was unsupervised by a staff member. The neighbor saw the child and was with him/her when the owner arrived, within minutes. Violation corrected during visit

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

Staplers, stapler removers, several pairs of adult size scissors and BIC correction fluid (liquid white out) were located on the top of children's cubbies in space 2 measuring 3 ft. high and on a child size shelf
