(2), Products That Are Labeled "Keep Out of Reach of Children" Without Any Other Warnings, Were Not Stored on a Shelf or in an Unlocked Cabinet That Is Five Feet... (1), and Electrical Outlets Not in Use Were Not Covered. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
