In space 4 and 5 there was no thermometer in the fridge. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/28/2026

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

A teacher in space 5 did not have shoes on. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/28/2026

● **All Corrosive Agents, Pesticides, Bleaches, Detergents, Cleansers, Polishes, Any Product Which Is Under Pressure in an Aerosol Dispenser, and Any Substance...**

which may be hazardous to a child if ingested, inhaled, or handled were not stored in a locked room or cabinet. In space 2 there

● **Prohibited Styrofoam and Foam Rubber Products Were Accessible to Children Under 3 Years of Age And/or Approved Foam Products Were Used Without Proper...**

supervision. In space 4 there was a cushion that had exposed foam to the children. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received fro

● **Center Staff Did Not Comply with the Safe Sleep Policy.**

In space 1 two infants were sleeping in carriers. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 5/28/2026
