(1), Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1), and Prior to Employment a Criminal Background Check Was Not Completed. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Prior to Employment a Criminal Background Check Was Not Completed.**

One (1) staff member, Maggie Beam, employed on October 27, 2025, in the licensed NC Pre-Kindergarten Program, did not obtain a criminal background check qualifying letter until November 7, 2025. Violation confirmed co
