● **Parent's Medication Authorization Did Not Include Required Information.**

One child's epi-pen did not have a medication authorization form. Teachers in a classroom were unable to locate a child's epi-pen during today's visit. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provide

● **All Staff Did Not Successfully Complete Certification in First Aid Appropriate to the Age of Children in Care.**

Verification of staff completion of First Aid training from an approved training organization was not in the staff file. Two staff members did not have current First Aid cert
