Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1), Monthly Playground Inspections Were Not Completed And/or They Were Not Completed by an Individual Trained in Playground Safety Requirements. (1), and The Center Did Not Complete an EPR Plan Within Four Months of Completing the EPR in Child Care Training And/or the Plan Was Not Completed on a Template... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

For March 2025 only one (1) item on page one of the playground inspection was answered. There was no playground inspection completed for Decemb

provided by the Division. The director could not locate the EPR plan. The owner emailed the director a copy of the facility's EPR

- **The Child Care Administrator and All Staff Did Not Complete the Recognizing and Responding to Suspicions of Child Maltreatment Training Within 90 Days Of...**

employment. The training was older than twelve (12) months to the employee's hire date of June 13, 2025. Violation confirmed correc
