In the classroom for children ages one-year-of-age there were three (3) feeding plans that were not signed by the teacher or the parent. Violation corrected d

Jun 19, 2024 1 Finding ● 1 Important

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

A three-year-old child entered the building and went into the classroom without supervision of staff members on 6/13/24 at approximately 10:50 am. The child was unsupervised for approximately two (2) minutes and nine (9) seconds. V
